4.RSPCA v Myers

Various dogs, cats and reptiles. 162 cruelty charges dropped to 6. First known case where court summons the prosecution to produce re homed animals.

5.RSPCA v W. Davies

Horses, Cambridgeshire Police lambasted by High Court for failure to follow procedures, costs ordered against Cambridgeshire Constabulary. No evidence offered.

6.RSPCA v Savage

Sheep, no evidence offered.
