Career Details

Following his appointment as QC Andrew Stubbs intends to continue his practice in Fraud, Serious Crime, Family and Regulatory Breach including Health and Safety.

Leading Cases

- 1. R-v-Edge*
Defence in murder by suffocation of disabled man in his own house so that his carer could inherit his estate.
- 2. R-v-Davis*
Defence in alleged murder of victim said to have explicit photographs of the defendant's mother. Defendant acquitted of murder and manslaughter.
- 3. R-v-Morley*
Prosecution of former 'Mr Gay UK' for killing, carving, cooking and then consuming his victim.

4. *Operation Pixie*
Prosecuted 24 defendant bogus insurance claim conspiracy, in a series of trials lasting 6 months.
5. *R v Latif*
Defended kidnap, torture and murder of a schizophrenic girl by a group of 5 teenagers.
6. *R v Jackson*
Corporate manslaughter undertaken on behalf of HSE and CPS.
7. *R v Burrows*
Prosecution of former director of Manchester United for investment fraud.
8. *Operation Caddy*
Longest overseas undercover operation ever mounted. Prosecution of drug importation from Spain. Issues of PII, Spanish Law, extradition, financial evidence from overseas, letters of request and asset tracing in confiscation hearings.
9. *Operation Aberdeen*
'Meat fraud' involving the introduction of condemned pet food into the human food chain. Also involved in the confiscation proceedings that followed conviction.
10. *R v Papanikitas*
Junior defence Counsel in a fraudulent trading/conspiracy to defraud. Involved a web of 'phoenix' companies and the tracing of assets through off-shore companies.
11. *Operation Churchill*
Fraud and Money Laundering Prosecution involving 14 defendants
12. *R-v-Stokes*
Defence of alleged money laundering team involving several solicitors, pre trial arguments and submissions lead to case being dropped.
13. *R-v-Sthankiya*
Defence of SFO prosecution which was stayed as an abuse following submissions as to the disclosure exercise.
